SUBJECT: INSPECTION AND CERTIFICATION FEE INCREASES

Effective July 1, 2017, fees for inspection and certification services will be increased. The adjustments will result in increases to phytosanitary certificate fees and inspection service fees during regular business hours and after business hours. Preparation of phytosanitary certificates (including Certificates of Quarantine Compliance) and inspection services will be charged following the new fees below. These increases do not recover our actual cost of providing these services, but will help us to continue to deliver the same level of service.

County prepares export document	\$18.00	\$20.00
Company prepares export document	\$13.00	\$16.00
Inspection for certification during office hours (per call)	\$42.00	\$46.00
Added fee for inspection after hours (per call)	\$35.00	\$38.00
